

Handyman Service

Our handyman service is a non-profit making service and may be able to help you if you are:

- Over 60 years of age or Disabled (of any age)
- Living in the local authority area of Hartlepool
- A housing hartlepool tenant

Do I need to be referred?

No, referrals are not necessary and anyone can request assistance from this service provided they meet the criteria listed above.

Appointments

Once we receive your details we will arrange a convenient date and time when the work can be carried out. We will then visit your home and carry out the required work.

On completion of the work we will ask you to sign a simple completion form and then you will be invoiced accordingly.

Permission should be sought from the landlord before any alterations or repairs to permanent fixtures and fittings can be undertaken.

Do you:

- Know who to turn to, to get small repair jobs done around your home?
- Worry about who you can trust to carry out the repairs?
- Put off having that small repair or home safety job done because you are afraid of the cost?
- Need advice on energy efficiency
- Need advice on dealing with doorstep callers and rogue traders?

How much does it cost?

Our handyman service is run on a not-for-profit basis and any charges we make goes towards the costs of running the scheme. This ensures that we can assist as many people as possible.

Our charges are:

£7 per hour inclusive of VAT

However, there will be NO charge for pensioners or disabled people.

There may also be a charge for any materials that we supply to complete the job and this will be agreed with you before any work starts.

In many cases our customers supply their own materials and this is quite acceptable.

You have the right to review the work and cancel at anytime with out incurring any further costs.

Provision & fitting of grab rails & extra banister rails



Joinery type repairs, doors, shelving, skirting, frames



Small scale jobs; leaking taps, replacing tap handles with lever handles



Rewiring plugs and fitting fuses



Fitting of door bolts, chains & security key safes



Changing light bulbs/shades & fitting door bells



Small scale painting & decorating jobs, wallpapering, hanging curtains etc



Small scale pruning & hedging to clear pathways for safer passage
